Grand Paradise Show Fees:

- Dressage / Jumping class fee - \$20 per class or \$50 per division which consists of 3 classes
- Western Dressage class fee - \$20 per class or \$60 per division which consists of 4 classes
- Jumping warm up (All day) - \$5 per round
- Lead line class \$10– All ages can participate
- Stick Horse \$10 – All ages can participate
- Office Admin / Grounds Fee - \$20 per horse/rider combination fee per day
- Dressage Post Entry Fee - \$10 per class if signing up after closing date of May 4th

Ribbons / Trophies

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st thru 6th place. One Grand Champion trophy will be awarded for each division as shown below:

Grand Champion Trophy Rules:

- To qualify the horse/rider combination must show in all the classes within the division
- Horses may be shown in the same class more than once, but the horse/rider combination can only be shown once.
- Horses may be shown in multiple levels ranging from intro all the way up
- The horse/rider combination with the most points based on the placings earned in each of the divisions will win.
- Points based on placings are as follows: 1st place=6 points, 2nd place=5 points, 3rd place=4 points, 4th place=3 points, 5th place=2 points and 6th place=1 point.
